Layout

- 5.5 spaces between staves
- 3 extra spaces between groups of staves
- 3 extra spaces below vocal staves (for lyrics)
- 3 extra spaces above for System Object Positions
- 9.25 spaces between systems
 Prefer fewer bars in a system that would naturally end at a locked bar

Justification
Justify staves when page is at least 65 % full
 Justify both staves of grand staff instruments
 Justify all staves of multi-staff instruments

System spacings may be contracted to 97 %

Values are subject to page justification
